The following Press was notified of the meeting by mail or by fax in accordance with the Freedom of information: The Calhoun Times and The Times and Democrat.


Chairman Summers called the meeting to order.

Invocation was offered by Chaplain Helen Carson.



Mr. Bowers stated that with the census it appeared that Calhoun County had only one plan that was beneficial to all. Council reviewed plans presented and asked questions. The floor was opened for comment by the citizens in the meeting. Chairman David Summers asked several in the room if the plan would work for the NAACP and others. Mr. Bowers was very helpful and answered all questions.

After everyone had time to review the maps, Mr. Thornton made a motion to have first reading on Ordinance 1-2011 An Ordinance To Provide And Adopt Calhoun County Council Electoral Districts Based Upon The 2010 Census and Approve Plan 1. Mr. Haigler seconded the motion. The motion passed.
